

High Adventure Shooting Sports Director

The high adventure shooting sports director is responsible for implementing a quality shooting sports program. He/she operates the shotgun and paintball programs and reports to the high adventure assistant director.

Minimum Requirements:

- At least 21 years of age.
- Successfully completed the shooting sports section of the BSA national camp school within the last 5 years.
- Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.

Important Qualities:

- Personal and Physical fitness.
- Sincere desire to help the Scouts and troops.
- Ability to get along with people.
- Technical knowledge of the BSA shooting sports program and an understanding of the care and maintenance of shooting sports equipment.
- Desire to maintain standards.
- Imagination and originality.
- Demonstrated ability to work as a team member.
- Previous experience as a shooting sports camp staff member.

Specific Duties:

- Maintain an inventory of all shooting equipment.
- Know safety regulations for all shooting equipment and shooting activity areas.
- Ensure the safe and proper storage of shooting equipment and ammunition.
- Supervise shooting sports areas.
- File the closing inventory at the end of the season.
- Ensure that national standards are met in shooting areas.
- Maintain a clean and orderly program area paying close attention to any potential hazards.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the high adventure director.
