High Adventure Assistant Director

The high adventure assistant director is responsible for overseeing the various outpost programs with the exception of the horse, COPE, and climbing programs. He/she supervises the necessary staff and functions as a member of the high adventure director's leadership team and assumes his/her responsibilities should he/she be unavailable.

Minimum Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age.
- Have a valid driver's license.
- Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.

Important Qualities:

- Personal and physical fitness.
- Sincere desire to help the Scouts and the troops.
- Ability to get along with people.
- Technical knowledge of the overall high adventure program at OSR.
- Desire to maintain standards.
- Imagination and originality.
- Demonstrated ability to work as a team member.
- Previous experience as a high adventure staff member.

Specific Duties:

- Assist the high adventure director in hiring a mature, well-rounded staff.
- Supervise the outpost programs and staff with the exception of the COPE, climbing, and horse programs.
- Assist the high adventure director in ensuring compliance with all BSA, state, and local camp and high adventure activity standards.
- Function as a back up driver for trip and trek programs should they be necessary.
- Assume the responsibility of the high adventure director in his/her absence.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the high adventure director.
