

## Dining Hall Director

The dining hall director is responsible for implementing a clean and well-run dining hall experience. He/she works closely with the entire camp staff as well as the food preparation staff and functions as a member of the camp director's leadership team.

### Minimum Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age.
- Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.

### Important Qualities:

- Personal and physical fitness.
- Sincere desire to help the Scouts and the troops.
- Ability to get along with people.
- Technical knowledge of dining hall operations.
- Desire to maintain standards.
- Imagination and originality.
- Demonstrated ability to work as a team member.

### Specific Duties:

- Provide leadership and direction to camp staff and campers during meals and dining hall program.
- Ensure portion control is maintained.
- Ensure that food counts are accurate.
- Maintain all necessary standards of occupancy and cleanliness.
- Provide leadership for the over dining hall program.
- Ensure meals are served on time.
- Maintain a clean and orderly dining hall paying close attention to any potential hazards.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the camp director.
