

Archery Director

The archery director is responsible for the instruction and operation of the archery range and program at camp. He/she reports to the shooting sports director.

Minimum Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age.
- Registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.

Important Qualities:

- Personal and physical fitness.
- Sincere desire to help the Scouts and the troops.
- Ability to get along with people.
- Technical knowledge of archery and archery instruction.
- Desire to maintain standards.
- Imagination and originality.
- Demonstrated ability to work as a team member.

Specific Duties:

- Maintain a clean and orderly program area.
- Operate a safe and secure range.
- With the assistance of the shooting sports director, develop a dynamic merit badge instruction program.
- Run all archery related activities and events in camp.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the shooting sports director or the camp director.
