Aquatics Instructor/Aquatics Senior Instructor

The aquatics instructor functions as a member of the aquatics staff in camp and helps with the instruction of the aquatics program. He/she reports to the aquatics director.

Minimum Requirements:

- At least 16 years of age. (18 years of age for Senior Instructor)
- Be a strong swimmer.
- Registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.

Important Qualities:

- Personal and physical fitness.
- Sincere desire to help the Scouts and the troops.
- Ability to get along with people.
- Technical knowledge of the aquatics program.
- Understanding of basic water safety.
- Desire to maintain standards.
- Imagination and originality.
- Demonstrated ability to work as a team member.
- Lifeguard BSA or similar qualification.

Specific Duties:

- Maintain a clean and orderly program area.
- With the help of the area director, develop a dynamic merit badge instruction program for all assigned merit badges.
- Help instruct in all aquatics program activities.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Aquatics director and/or camp director.
