

Reneker Program Director

The Reneker Program Director is responsible for the overall program at Reneker Family Camp. He/she supervises the program staff and functions as a member of the Camp Director's leadership team.

Minimum Requirements:

- At least 21 years of age.
- Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.

Important Qualities:

- Personal and physical fitness.
- Sincere desire to help the Scouts and the troops.
- Ability to get along with people.
- Technical knowledge of the Reneker family camp program.
- Desire to maintain standards.
- Imagination and originality.
- Demonstrated ability to work as a team member.
- Previous experience as a Reneker staff member.

Specific Duties:

- Supervise and train the Reneker program staff.
- With the assistance of the camp director, develop a quality age appropriate program for Scout families.
- Maintain an inventory of all program equipment and supplies.
- Ensure all BSA, state, and local family camp standards are met.
- Provide a basis for improved program next year by making a written report with recommendations.
- Handle or participate in certain activities and frequently drop in on others to be certain of quality of staff operation.
- Confer with individual staff personnel about the quality of their work.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the camp director.
